

Important information to our customers

In accordance with the change in the Marpol-convention regulating the maximum permitted sulphur content in marine fuels, a new Low Sulphur Directive will be in effect from January 1st 2015. The new directive dictates that the maximum sulphur content in marine fuels is lowered from the current 1,0% to 0,1% The directives scope is for all traffic in the Baltic Sea, North Sea and the English Channel (SECA area).

Currently there is intensive work within the affected ferry companies to find ways to comply with the new directive. At Bring, we must therefore notify you that this will lead to an increase in cost for 2015 and onwards. The work is still ongoing and we are currently in a phase where we cannot predict exactly how big the cost increase will be. However we are following the developments closely.

Our intent is to update you with this information as soon as possible, and let you know how it will affect the cost for Brings transportation services.
