

Current information from Bring Air & Sea with regard to the situation in Ukraine.

In light of the situation in Ukraine, Bring Air & Sea would like to inform about possible consequences and measures. The situation is changing every minute and we are following the situation closely.

- Train transport: For the time being, Bring Air & Sea has stopped all planned train transport from Asia to Europe, as the railway runs via Russia and Belarus. There is a high risk in connection with these transports, as the sanctions against these countries are expected to be met with slow-moving actions from Russia's part. It is also likely that the rail transport through Russia will be restricted as long as there are acts of war.
- Air transport: Closed airspace in Europe causes change of flight routes and transport time may increase.
- Sea transport: Limitations in connection to train and air transports cause higher pressure to the global sea freight and we are expecting challenges regarding capacity going forward. We request our customers to expect longer transport time between Europe and Asia.

Increased energy costs are also a consequence of the situation in Ukraine, as Russia is a major supplier of natural gas to Europe. This causes increased fuel costs and an expected increase of transport prices for both the air and sea market.

Safety is our main priority, and we will do everything within our power to minimize consequences for our customers.
